- Athletes/participants are not permitted to change their clothing in the activity areas.
- Please do not bring any glassware into the activity areas, including onto the pool deck. All beverages should be in a sealed, spill proof container.
- Please remind swimmers' family members, parents/guardians are not permitted on the pool deck for safety reasons, except if they are officiating.

Warm Up and Cool Down

- Warm Up:
 - Lane1 & 8, one way will be diving lanes.
 - Lane 7, one way will be setting up backstroke ledges during the last 20 minutes warmup time and will be one way swim.
 - There will not be any lanes available for warm up or cool down once the meet has started

Scratches

- The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this competition.
- Late Scratch Deadline 30 minutes prior to the start of the session
- Deck Entries WILL NOT BE PERMITTED
- Official Split Deadline 30 minutes prior to the start of the session

Swimmer Information

- Inform Meet Management and the Advisory Referee of all PARA swimmers from your club at the start of each session and discuss if your swimmer(s) will require special attention or assistance on deck, including at the starting blocks.
- Inform the Session Referee of any swimmers from your club that have medical taping and an accompanying doctor's note of any kind.
- If your swimmer(s) have to withdraw from the meet, at any time, as a result of a medical condition, etc., please notify the meet manager and advisory referee, ASAP.

Prizes - Bell Ringer & Medals

- Heats will be randomly chosen during sessions 1, 2, 3 and 4. At the beginning of that heat a bell will ring to indicate it is a prize heat. Swimmers winning that heat will receive a prize. Winners will be announced during the swim meet and are asked to collect their prize from the prize table.
- All medals must be collected by the coach(es) at the conclusion of the Competition.
